Learn by Doing Workshops

Two types of Learn by Doing Workshops are scheduled for the dates shown below. Everyone who participates must be at least 8 years old.

The Food Challenge Boot Camp covers basic cooking skills and teaches campers all about the 4-H Food Challenge contest. The two-day workshop is \$10 for 4-H members and \$20 for non-members.
