FOR THOSE ENTERING A NEW HORSE INTO 4-H CONNECT, BEFORE YOU BEGIN YOUR VALIDATION PROCESS, YOU MUST:

Have a family and youth member profile established on 4-H CONNECT

Be an active/paid youth member of Texas 4-H for the 2014-2015 year.

For any horse which was NOT validated in 4-H CONNECT last year, have digital photos of your horse(s) from the front, left side, and right side. These photos must be accessible for upload during the validation process.

For any registered horse that was NOT validated last year you will need to have a pdf copy of your horse(s) registration papers for upload.

LCFA FCS Division Reminders

It's time to start thinking about your Family & Consumer Sciences division entries for the county show. Things to remember:

- This year we are sticking to rule #11—food entries may only be on a disposable board or paper plate and covered in clear plastic wrap. This year we will NOT be accepting any entries in decorated baskets, covered cake sets, or similar. Entries will only be accepted if brought in on disposable goods. Please ask BEFORE check-in if you are not sure!
- For food items (class 1-15), a copy of the recipe must be turned in with the entry form.
- Another copy of the recipe (without your name) must also be attached to the food item upon check-in.
- Entry fees—Class 1-15 is \$3.00 per item; Class 16-34 is \$1.00 per item.
- If you have not validated any animal projects, then the yearly family membership fee of \$10.00 (or lifetime \$100.00 membership) must be paid to the Limestone County Fair & Youth Livestock Show.

In addition to all the food classes, there are also classes that encompass paintings, photographs, drawings, needlework, woodwork, home décor, potted plants, and more. Check out the 2015 rulebook for more information.

If you are planning on showing steers at the State Fair, Fort Worth, San Antonio, San Angelo, Houston, or Austin in the 2015 fall or 2016 spring, then you must order tags by Wednesday, April 15th to the Extension Office. Tags will be \$11 each and they will have you eligible to enter to participate in the shows.

Remember, you must still fill out entries in November.
