October 30th is the county deadline to have your green form & payment in to the Extension Office in order to meet the LCFA deadline of November 1 for show eligibility.

Note—Clover Kids do not pay a participation fee—the fee only applies to bonafide 4-H members who are at least 8 years old and in the 3rd grade.
