### **New 4-H Year**

Are you ready for another great 4-H year? Limestone County 4-H is! It's time to start enrolling for the 2013-2014 4-H year. Be sure to fill out your green enrollment form and turn it in to your club manager or to Wanda in the Extension office. Remember that the participation fee is only \$20 before November 1. October 30th is the county deadline to have your green form & payment in to the Extension office for one step in the LCFA show eligibility. Note—Clover Kids do not pay a participation fee—the fee only applies to bonafide 4-H members who are at least 8 years old and in the 3rd grade.


